



**HANDICRAFT TIP**

Celestial joy. Angel choir and guardian angel out of wooden peg dolls.

## Used items:

<b>64 536 505</b>	Raw wood peg doll, 7.7 cm, 4 pcs	1 piece
<b>46 624 505</b>	Decorative wood stars	2 pieces
<b>85 143 02</b>	Decorative feather, white	1 piece
<b>38 000 532</b>	All-purpose paint, nougat	1/30 bottle
<b>38 001 620</b>	Metallic paint, brilliant gold	1/30 bottle

## Additionally you need:

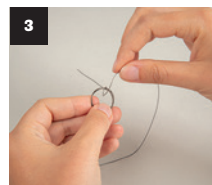
<b>33 376 00</b>	Mini hot-melt glue gun, low-temperature
<b>38 241 00</b>	Painting sponge

White strong paper, paintbrush, pencil, scissors, floral wire



## Instructions:

- 1 Start by bending the halo. To do this, cut about 50 cm of floral wire.
- 2 After about 4 cm, bend the wire into the shape of a ring (with a diameter of about 2 cm). The halo looks beautiful with 4 more rings.
- 3 Join the 5 rings together with wire and wrap the remaining wire around the 4 cm wire (from the beginning) for greater stability.
- 4 Paint a surface area (measuring about 10 × 10 cm) of the white paper with the nougat-coloured all-purpose paint. Once the paint is dry, you can wipe it to get a metallic sheen. To do this, use a damp painting sponge to apply the brilliant gold metallic paint and wipe gently over the nougat-coloured surface.
- 5 When the surface is dry, draw the wings using the template and cut them out.
- 6 For the sheet music book, you can cut out a stave from, e.g. "Silent Night" and fold it into a sheet music.
- 7 To finish your guardian angel, first glue the decorative feather, then the halo and finally the wings to the angel's upper back. Affix the sheet music book with two small drops of glue.

<b>85 143 02</b>	Decorative feather, white	6 pieces
<b>52 106 02</b>	Chenille wire, white	8 cm
<b>38 000 314</b>	All-purpose paint, purple	1/30 bottle
<b>35 047 268</b>	Chalky, dusky pink	1/30 bottle
<b>35 047 414</b>	Chalky, lime green	1/30 bottle
<b>65 201 000</b>	Wood disc, round natural, ø 10-12 cm	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

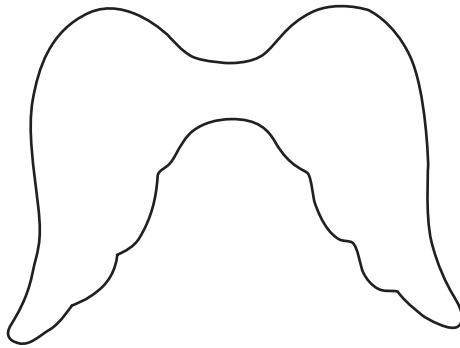
- 33 376 00** Mini hot-melt glue gun, low-temperature  
**35 035 576** Multi-Liner (black)  
 White strong paper, paintbrush, needle, scissors, pencil, floral wire



## Instructions:

- 1 Paint the body of the wood peg dolls in the different chalky colour shades and let them dry.
- 2 For the hair of the purple angel, you need three 7 cm long yarn pieces. To join these 3 pieces, wrap a piece of floral wire around the middle.
- 3 For the hairdo, loosen the cords to make hair look fuller. To untwist them easily, use a needle.
- 4 Then glue the hair to the head by means of hot-melt glue drop.
- 5 Once they have dried, you can cut the hair into shape. Do the same for the raffia hair of the pink angel. The haircut is slightly shorter and fringy.
- 6 For the curly hair of the lime green angel, glue small pieces of decorative paper grass compactly to the head and cut the "hair" to desired length.
- 7 Paint the faces with the multi-liner.
- 8 Trace the wing contours three times onto white paper using the template and cut them out.
- 9 For the sheet music book, you can cut out a stave from, e.g. "Silent Night" and fold it into a sheet music.
- 10 Finally, glue the wings, chenille wire, sheet music and decorative feathers onto the angels and place the angel choir on a wood disc to your liking.
