Soap „Bonjour“ with Buddha



Used items:

34 228 000	Creative-soap	35 g
34 292 000	Labels "Bonjour", Buddha	
34 233 000	Soap casting mould: rectangle	
34 246 408	Soap colour mint-green	1-2 drops
34 251 000	Soap fragrance oil, Green tea	1 drop

Additionally you need:

Stove, melt, melting pot, scale, small plastic container, craft stick as a stirrer or teaspoon, tablespoon



Instructions:

- 1 Melt the transparent creative-soap in a water-bath on the stove (max. 60° - do not boil).
- 2 Stir 2 drops of the mint-green soap colour in 2/3 of the liquid soap. Therefore, use a craft stick or a teaspoon.
- 3 For the soaps with motif or logo, place upwards the label with the stamping.
- 4 To avoid blistering or slipping of the label, use at best a tablespoon with which you fill the casting mould with the liquid soap.
- 5 Fill 2/3 of your soap casting mould with the liquid soap and let the soap cool down until a sort of curd forms on the surface. You can pour thereon your remaining white soap. Let the soap dry well out (at least 2-3 hours, ideally one day).
- 6 Demould the soap by a slight pressure. Remove the label at best with a pointed object e.g. a needle.
- 7 **Tip** Let the finished soap dry at best for 2-3 weeks; the longer it ripens, the firmer becomes.
- 7 Depending on the temperature and airiness, the soap can perspire. We therefore recommend to wrap the soap after its demoulding in a transparent foil for flowers (cellophane).
- 8 Clean the soap casting mould and the pots with hot water.
