# Soap cardboard cup





## Used items:

<b>34 222 000</b>	Bath salt
<b>34 246 210</b>	Soap colour, orange
<b>34 223 000</b>	Kneading-soap
<b>34 246 264</b>	Soap colour, pink
<b>68 068 000</b>	Bio cardboard cup with lid, 300 ml
<b>38 000 102</b>	All Purpose paint, white
<b>38 000 276</b>	All Purpose paint, fuchsia
<b>55 704 258</b>	Glitter tape, pinkish
<b>55 472 00</b>	Organza ribbon with dots white/white
<b>79 668 306</b>	Scrapbooking-paper: glitter, lilac
<b>80 297 102</b>	Metallic paper, FSC Mix Credit white
<b>29 071 000</b>	Stamp "Seifenkiste"
<b>28 390 316</b>	Ink-pad "Memento", plum
<b>89 647 00</b>	Motif punch: oval
<b>89 744 00</b>	Motif punch: oval with deco-border
<b>6109800</b>	Wooden skewers
<b>8937800</b>	Scissors

## Additionally you need:

Kettle, brush, cooking oil, craft stick, vessel for stirring

## Instructions:

- 1 Mix the kneading-soap with hot water and the cooking oil, e.g. 100g of kneading-soap with 40ml of hot water and about 10ml of oil.
- 2 Stir this mixture with a craft stick and let it rest for 10 minutes.
- 3 Then knead well once more the compound and paint it in portions in the hand with the corresponding soap colours. Now you can shape single balls as of this compound.
- 4 Impale the single balls onto the wooden skewers and let them dry well.
- 5 During the drying time, paint the bio cardboard cup as well the lid by using the All Purpose paint.
- 6 Once the cup has dried out, you can decorate it with ribbons and punched & stamped elements.
- 7 Fill the cup with the bath salt and insert the decorated wooden skewers with the kneading-soaps into the cup.
