



HANDICRAFT TIP



Decorative fruity highlights.
Make you want to bite into
them.



Used items:

Apple, sequin spangles to be scattered

- 33 489 000** Styrofoam apple with stalk 1 p.
30 234 000 Glitter glue 1/50 bottle
39 258 58 Glitter, yellow gold 1/20 box

Additionally you need:

- 33 601 00** Dry foam brick 1 piece
61 098 00 Wooden skewer, 3 mm 1 piece
37 319 000 Brush set "Chalky Basic" 1 piece
Paper as a base

Instruction:

- 1 Use a sheet of paper as a working surface. Put the bigger styrofoam apple on the wooden skewer and spread the glue onto it evenly by means of the brush.
- 2 Then sprinkle the yellow gold sequin spangles over the glue so that it is entirely covered.
- 3 Now, push the apple into the dry foam brick out.
- 4 Collect the remaining sequin spangles on a sheet of paper and pour them back into their container.



Used items:

Apple, granite look

- 33 489 000** Styrofoam apple with stalk 1 p.
34 434 558 Granite-effect spray, stone grey approx. 1/5 box

Additionally you need:

- 33 601 00** Dry foam brick 1 piece
61 098 00 Wooden skewer, 3 mm 1 piece
Sellotape

Instruction:

- 1 Glue the stalk of the styrofoam apple with a piece of sellotape.
- 2 Then skewer the apple in the bottom centre with the wooden skewer.
- 3 Insert the apple vertically into the dry foam brick and underlay the brick with a sheet of paper or an old newspaper.
- 4 After briefly shaking the spray can, spray all sides of the apple at a distance of approx. 25 cm. After about half an hour, repeat this step to achieve a nice rich coating.

HINT: Spray outdoors if possible.



Used items:

Pear, glossy look

- 33 490 000** Styrofoam pear with stalk 1 p.
38 000 576 All Purpose paint, black 1/40 bot.
38 066 000 Triple Gloss 1/15 bottle

Additionally you need:

- 33 601 00** Dry foam brick 1 piece
61 098 00 Wooden skewer, 3 mm 1 piece
37 053 000 Brush set "Hobby Kreativ"
Paper as a base

Instruction:

- 1 Skewer the pear in the bottom centre with the wooden skewer and paint it with the black All Purpose paint by the means of the flat brush from the brush set. Let it dry well out.
- 2 Use a new flat brush to apply the Triple Gloss varnish onto the pear, quickly and evenly.
- 3 Let the varnish dry well out.
- 4 Then apply the second coat of varnish. It is recommended to apply two thin coats of varnish, otherwise the varnish leaves droplet-shaped traces!
- 5 To dry it out, always push the pear vertically into the dry foam brick.
