



HANDICRAFT TIP

The Wild West brought home. Make cute Figures out of wooden clothes pegs.

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Used items:

Teepee

69 262 505	Wood craft box basic,	
	round wooden sticks, 15 cm long	5 pieces
55 951 685	Backer's twine mix, pastel shades	70 cm
53 007 49	Felt, 10 assorted colours	ca. 15 × 25 cm
85 168 01	Fluffy feather, black	1-2 piece(s)
85 168 28	Fluffy feather, reddish brown	1-2 piece(s)

Additionally you need:

89 378 00 Craft scissors **33 407 00** Craft glue

Instruction:

- 1 First, tie 5 wooden sticks together at one end to make a shape of teepee.
 To ensure proper spacing of the wooden sticks, use our template at the rear side (teepee) to do this. Then fix the wooden sticks in place where they come in contact with the craft glue.
- 2 Then cut out the felt according to the template (felt). The baker's twine is firmly glued to the felt as edging.
- 3 Now lay the felt around the wooden sticks so that the teepee entrance is created too. Then glue the felt firmly to the wooden sticks.
- Finally, wind some baker's twine decoratively around the top of the teepee and insert a few feathers into the tip-top. Your teepee is now ready!

Additionally you need:

Instruction:

Felt cuttings for 1 figure each

Head: Cut out 4 circles with a diameter of 1.6 cm and glue them

together.

Skirt: 5 cm × 2 cm

Belt: 5 cm × 0,8 cm

Neck: 1.5 cm × 0,8 cm

Shoes: 2 cuttings measuring 0.5 cm × 1 cm each

Sisal cord

Hair: 7 pieces, each one 11 cm long

- 1 Start by making the body, using 1 small clothes peg and 1 small wooden stick. First, cut pieces measuring 1.5 cm from the rounded side of both wooden sticks and glue them firmly to the clothes pegs as shoes. Then glue the small felt cutouts onto shoes.
- 2 Put the skirt/belt around the clothes peg and glue them. For the neck, fold the felt strip and glue it to the top of the clothes peg. When the glue has dried out, the head can be glued on.
- 3 As for the hair, untwist the sisal cord, then glue the individual strands onto the head to get a hairdo. Then draw the eyes with the Multi-Liner marker. With the baker's twine, you can make a headband and wrap the plaits. Finally, attach a small feather to the headband to adorn your little doll.

With a few branches and wood from the garden, a great tepee village can be created.
