Happy Easter.
Candle in a Raysin saucer.



Used items:

| 31 661 000 | Transfer foil „Frohe Ostern“ | 1 piece |
| 31 402 00 | Pillar candle | 1 piece |
| 36 175 000 | Silicone casting mould Coaster Ring | 1 piece |
| 36 990 00 | Casting powder "Raysin" 200 | 1 bag |
| 31 640 990 | Pigments for wax, rainbow | 1 piece |
| 85 004 11 | Icelandic moss, green | approx. 3 g |
| 65 395 000 | Maidenhair vine, decorative twig | some |
| 46 776 999 | Wooden shapes Bunny, colourful | 2 pieces |

Additionally you need:

33 487 000 Glue Fix pen
Mixing vessel, leftover candle wax, glass, pot, stovetop, sandpaper if required



Instructions:

- 1 Mix the white Raysin casting powder with water according to the instructions given and fill the casting mould Saucer with the resulting casting compound. After about three hours drying time, demould the cast item from the casting mould.
- 2 Melt the leftover candle wax and dye it with the wax colour pigments. Take the pillar candle and dip it in the melted coloured wax and let it dry.
- 3 Once the coloured wax is dry, decorate the candle with the motif from the transfer foil "Frohe Ostern".
- 4 Place the candle on the cast saucer and surround it with decorative Maidenhair vine twigs and Icelandic moss. Stick the bunnies decoratively onto the twigs and onto the outer edge of the saucer.
