





# HANDICRAFT TIP

46 122 000	Plastic dome with base, ø 8 cm	1 piece
34 500 00	Fine papier-maché, bag of 400 g	1/10 bag
85 491 264	Dried flower bouquet	1 piece
64 530 505	Wood pick Lavender, FSC Mix Credit	2 pieces

### Additionally you need:

Acrylic roller, cookie cutter Circle (ø 4 cm), adhesive, scissors, cling film



## Instructions:

- 1 Take a piece of "Feinstes Papiermaché" from the packaging and close the packaging airtight so that it does not dry out.
- 2 Prepare a smooth surface with the cling film and flatten (using e.g. the acrylic roller) the torn pieces of papier-mâché evenly to get a thick surface of about 3-4 mm.
- 3 Cut out a disc with the cookie cutter Circle and use it as a base to insert in dried flowers for your imagined decoration. Shorten the wood picks Lavender to about 10 cm using the craft scissors.
- 4 Insert the dried flowers and the wood picks Lavender to your liking into the insert-in base and allow them to dry for two days.

TIP: For coloured dried flowers, poke a hole in the spot of your choice, remove the dried flowers to dry the insert-in base. Once the base is dry, insert them back and glue them to keep them in place. Coloured dried flowers may stain the insert-in base.

5 Then affix the whole in the middle of the wooden base and put the dome cover over.

HANDICRAFT TIP

Summer is just ahead. Dried flowers and wood picks in a glass jar.

#### **Used items:**

56 612 000	Glass container with cork lid, ø 9.5 cm	1 piece
38 000 267	All-purpose paint, pink	1/100 bottle
38 000 428	All-purpose paint, leafgreen	1/100 bottle
64 531 505	Wood pick Poppy & Grass, FSC Mix Credit	1 bag
85 490 505	Dried flower bouquet with paper sleeve	1 bouguet
85 490 505	Dried flower bouquet with paper sleeve	i bouquet

# Additionally you need:

Paintbrush, hot melt glue gun, scissors, jute cord

# Instructions:

- 1 Paint the wood picks Poppy with the all-purpose paint and let them dry well out.
- 2 Drill holes in the cork lid using the gimlets. Use the gimlet of 2-3 mm for the dried flowers and the 5-6 mm one for the wood picks. Insert the dried flowers and the painted wood picks into the pre-drilled holes.
- 3 Put carefully the glass jar over the dried flowers inserted in the cork lid. Then you can decorate further your glass jar with a jute cord, additional dried flowers or wood picks.







TIP: You can also use the glass jar turned upside-down. If doing so, make a small bouquet out of dried flowers, in which you could insert e.g. the wooden pick Eucalyptus (item no. 64 528 505). Affix the bouquet to the bottom of the jar using the hot melt glue gun. Then close the jar with the cork lid and decorate it to your liking.
