



## CRAFTING IDEA

GB

Small but mighty. Everything ready-to-hand in a crochet utility item.

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## Used items:

**42 010 372** Braided Recycling yarn, braided, 4 mm

1 clew

**56 968 000** Leatherette labels, handmade

1 label

## Additionally you need:

**89 378 00** Craft scissors

Crochet hook thickness 8 mm

Sewing needle and thread



## Pattern used:

### DOUBLE CROCHETS

Work in spiral rounds, i.e. do not close the round with 1 slip stitch, but simply continue working.

### CROCHET KNIT STITCH

Work double crochets, but do not work around the stitch on top, always stick the needle between the two V-shaped back loops of the previous round. Work in spiral rounds, i.e. do not close the round with 1 slip stitch, but simply continue working (Fig. 1-3).



### CROCHET PATTERN FOR THE BASKET WALL

Work alternately 1 normal **DOUBLE CROCHET** (work this only in the back chain stitch, Fig. 4-6) and 1 double crochet in **CROCHET KNIT STITCH (FIG. 1-3)**.

Work in spiral rounds, i.e. do not close the round with 1 slip stitch, but simply continue working.





## Instruction:

Start with the bottom.

**1<sup>st</sup> rd** Crochet 6 double crochets around an adjustable thread ring (Fig. 7-11). Pull the ring by making it smaller as you tighten the end of the thread (Fig. 12). Now continue working in spiral rounds, i.e. do not close the round with 1 slip stitch, but simply continue working. Mark the beginning of the round. From now on, continue working with **CROCHET KNIT STITCH**.

**2<sup>nd</sup> rd** Work 2 double crochets in each double crochet of the previous round = 12 double crochets result.






**3<sup>rd</sup> rd** \* 1 double crochet, 2 double crochets in 1 stitch, work from \* 6 times = 18 double crochets result

**4<sup>th</sup> rd** \* 2 double crochets, 2 double crochets in 1 stitch, work from \* 6 times = 24 double crochets result.

**5<sup>th</sup> rd** \* 3 double crochets, 2 double crochets in 1 stitch, work from \* 6 times = 30 double crochets result.

**6<sup>th</sup> rd** \* 4 double crochets, 2 double crochets in 1 stitch, work from \* 6 times = 36 double crochets result. Close the round with 1 slip stitch in the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet.

**7<sup>th</sup> rd** 36 slip stitches by working **around the stitches** of the previous round. Close the round with 1 slip stitch in the 1<sup>st</sup> slip stitch (Fig. 13-15).





#### BASKET WALL



**8<sup>th</sup> rd** Work 36 double crochets by working only around the back chain stitches of the 6<sup>th</sup> round (Fig. 16-18).

**9<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> rd** Work 36 stitches in **THE CROCHET PATTERN FOR THE BASKET WALL**. Close the 16<sup>th</sup> round with 1 slip stitch in the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet to close the round.

**17<sup>th</sup> rd** 36 slip stitches by working **around the stitches** of the previous round. Close the round with 1 slip stitch in the 1<sup>st</sup> slip stitch. Cut the thread and sew on the inside.

#### FINALISATION

Sew on the label using the sewing needle and thread.



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
