LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY

Used items:

25 118 000	Vintage metallic message plate	1 piece
29 106 000	Stamp "Do WHAT you LOVE"	1 piece
28 383 576	Stamp pad "StazOn", black	1 piece
28 383 280	Stamp pad "StazOn", fiery red	1 piece
24 070 00	Iron wire, annealed	75 cm
55 517 287	Yarn, 1 mm ø, classical red	40 cm
38 732 00	PP-foil	1/30 sheet
30 071 000	Double-sided adhesive tape, extra strong	30 cm

Additionally you need:

28 382 00	Stamp cleaner
89 378 00	Craft scissors
89 279 00	Strong side cutter, 15 cm
89 206 00	Tweezers, 11.5 cm

Instructions:

Finish the 2 stencils out of the PP-foil as shown in the sketches hereinafter.

1 Cover the upper area ("Do") and the lower heart of the stamp with the self-made stencil and affix it onto the stamp by means of the double-sided adhesive tape.

2 Dab the stamp with the black stamp pad and remove the stencil. Use tweezers to remove the stencil over the heart. Dab quickly the remaining areas with the red stamp pad.

3 Place the stamp in the middle of the metallic plate and stamp it. After that, clean the stamp and the stencils.

4 Shape a heart out of the iron wire up of 18 cm (measuring from the top of the wire), wrap the lower area of the metallic plate and twist together the wire at the rear side. Cut off the ends by means of the side cutter. After that, wrap twice the metallic plate with the red/white yarn.

Form a suspension by using the remaining wire.

Cut off the ends by means of the side cutter.
