



CRAFTING IDEA

Christmas tin boxes parade.
Cut out, glue, decorate.



Used items:

- 67 159 000** Papier-mâché box set, FSC Rec.100%, ø 6 cm
- 38 000 102** All-purpose paint, white
- 38 000 286** All-purpose paint, classic red
- 67 376 999** Craft paper, colour-assorted, DIN A4, colourful
- 67 375 576** Tinted cardboard, DIN A4, black
- 55 517 287** Yarn, ø 1 mm, classic red
- 67 302 999** Metallic mix crush paper, A4, colourful

Additionally you need:

- 33 396 000** Paper glue
- paintbrush set



Instruction:

- 1 Paint the papier-mâché box with the white All-purpose paint.
 - 2 Cut out the required pattern pieces from the craft paper using the cutting template. Cut out the star from the metallic gold crush paper.
 - 3 Cut the hat and the tree trunk from the black tinted cardboard. For the scarf, cut out a piece measuring 1 cm × 29 cm from the red craft paper and cut fringes on the sides. For the rim of the star-shaped box lid, you need a strip out of the metallic gold crush paper measuring 1 cm × 20 cm.
- TIP:** You can make the small golden dot for the top of the tree using a hole punch and metallic gold crush paper.
- 4 Glue the individual pattern pieces onto the tin box.
 - 5 Now you can decorate the tin box with dots using the All-purpose paint or ornate it with the yarn.
