Create a magical world by making a spa for the gnome.



## Used items:

<b>62 695 000</b>	Wood frame Houses	1 set
<b>61 353 31</b>	Mini wooden craft sticks	½ bag
<b>64 518 505</b>	Wood door gnome Nisse	1 piece
<b>35 077 576</b>	Allround Paint, acrylique, black	1/50 bottle
<b>67 270 360</b>	Tissue paper, sky-blue	approx.1/50
<b>88 268 00</b>	Metallic watering can + bucket	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

**33 487 000** Glue fix pen

Scissors, paintbrush, cotton thread, white fabric if necessary

## Instructions:

**1** Paint the outer sides of the houses and also the floor of the small house with the black Allround Paint. Leave everything to dry well.

### Sauna lounger

**2** To make the lounger, you will need 15 wooden craft sticks. Start with three sticks and cut the curves straight at the top and bottom using scissors. Then, split the sticks in two to get 6 pieces of the same size.

**3** Take two more wooden craft sticks and glue two of your shortly cut sticks horizontally in between by means of the glue fix pen. Allow to dry well.

**4** Then take the remaining four short wooden sticks and glue them as legs to the outer edge. Allow to dry again.

**5** Cut a straight side from each of the five wooden craft sticks. Cut another one straight on both sides. Successively fix the five sticks with a straight edge on top of your base structure. Use the remaining one at the front as a joint cover.

**6** To make the headrest, three cut wooden craft sticks must be glued together. To raise the headrest slightly, glue another stick to the sidewall of the house at the appropriate height.

### Shower block

**7** For the shower block, you need to make a small wooden ladder. To do this, remove the three wooden ends that poke out on one side to create a straight edge. Then, glue this same straight edge to the rear wall of the small shower block. Allow to dry well.

**8** Then stick another wooden craft stick vertically below this small ladder, in the middle of the rear wall.

**9** To decorate it, use the wooden hearts, the watering can, the bucket...

### Floor mats

**10** To make the floor mats, cut the ends of the wooden craft sticks so that both sides are straight and glue them to two other wooden sticks lengthways or widthways.

**TIP:** You could use the remaining wooden craft sticks to make other items for this spa, for example, a small sauna heater, a bench, a sauna towel, etc.

<b>67 034 000</b>	Papier-mâché box	1 piece
<b>61 353 31</b>	Mini wooden craft sticks	37 pieces
<b>35 077 576</b>	Allround Paint, acrylic, black	1/50 bottle
<b>67 270 360</b>	Tissue paper, sky-blue	1 sheet

## Additionally you need:

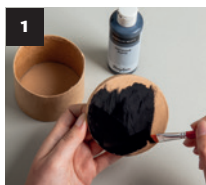
**33 487 000** Klebefix-Pen  
Scissors, paintbrush



## Instructions:

### Bathing accessories

- 1 Paint the lid of the box with the Allround black acrylic paint and allow to dry thoroughly.
- 2 Insert the box into the painted lid. Using the scissors, cut the two ends straight off the 37 wooden craft sticks.
- 3 Then stick the 37 wooden craft sticks around the box using the glue fix pen.
- 4 Finally, fill the hot tub with sky-blue tissue paper and affix a small wooden heart on.
