



**HANDICRAFT TIP**



Who wants to watch diligent craftsmen? Workbench made from wood craft sticks for gnomes.



## Used items:

<b>61 217 31</b>	Wooden craft sticks	approx. 15 pieces
<b>46 598 282</b>	Christmas wreath miniatures	1 piece
<b>86 257 00</b>	Metallic/wooden tools	1 bag
<b>66 075 444</b>	Decorative fir trees, snow-covered	2 pieces
<b>88 815 00</b>	Decorative broom, 9.5 cm	1 piece
<b>33 407 00</b>	Craft glue	
<b>39 579 102</b>	Decorative snowflakes, white	

## Additionally you need:

Scissors



## Instruction:

**1** Cut a wooden stick into three pieces (each of about 3.7 cm) for the tabletop. Position four wooden sticks precisely adjacent each other and glue the three cut-out pieces, spaced out evenly, across over. Let them dry out. Then stick a wood cover to the front and back side.

**2** Divide two wooden sticks in the middle (5.5 cm) and glue them equally-spaced as workbench legs.

**3** After drying, attach another wooden stick lengthwise and centrally on each side of the legs.

**4** Finally, cut a total of four long sticks (4.5 cm) from two more wooden sticks and glue them on as a shelf.

Have a lot of fun with the designing of your workbench, so your gnome can start working straightaway.
