62 833 000	Wooden holder with slots	1 piece
36 189 000	Silicone mould Gnome family	1 piece
66 059 000	Decorative snow-covered fir tree	1 piece
50 298 000	Clear Stamps - "Wichtelpost"	1 piece
28 383 576	Stamp pad "StazOn", black	1 piece
36 990 00	Casting powder "Raysin" 200	approx. 80 g
35 077 502	Allround Paint acrylic, eucalyptus	approx. 5 ml
35 077 506	Allround Paint acrylic, sandalwood	approx. 10 ml

Paintbrush, scissors, double-sided adhesive tape, mixing vessel, poss. sandpaper, hole punch pliers

## Instructions:

- 1 Mix 80 g of Raysin 200 following the instructions on the package and cast the gnome family and the fir trees to a thickness of about 4 mm.
- 2 After drying for about 1 hour, they should be carefully demoulded. However, the castings should be left to dry for one or two days. If necessary, you can sand the edges on the rear side with sandpaper.
- 3 Then, paint the gnome family with the acrylic paints. Let them dry thoroughly.
- 4 Paint the wooden holder with slots using the sandalwood-coloured acrylic paint. Let it dry thoroughly.
- 5 Use the motif puncher to make a gift tag out of cardboard. Apply the Clear Stamps "letterbox" stamp to the gift tag and the "footprint" stamp to the right-hand side of the wooden holder. Then hang the gift tag on the big fir tree using the gold cord.

And as a final stage, stick the snow-covered fir tree and the Raysin fir tree to the wooden holder using double-sided adhesive tape.
