# Zebra-picture with finger paint



## Used items:

<b>38 962 000</b>	Set of finger paints	1 set
<b>61 582 00</b>	Wooden frames stringed, 20 × 20 cm	1 piece
<b>73 124 521</b>	Card A4, Kraft, FSC Recycled Credit, Kraft	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

<b>30 203 000</b>	Double-sided adhesive tape, extra strong	approx. 1 m
<b>37 104 00</b>	Flat brush, synthetic	1 piece
<b>37 110 00</b>	Round brush, synthetic	1 piece



## Instructions:

**1** Paint the right children's hand palm richly with the white finger paint by using the flat brush. The hand imprint should be done with extended fingers.

**Tip** Press additionally onto the children's hand's pressure to achieve a complete impression of the hand palms.

**2** Turn the sheet so that you get a tail by the thumb's pressure.

**3** Once the paint has dried out, you can paint the zebra's head & the neck with a round brush. Therefore, mix some water with a small amount of the white paint. If necessary, apply the colour twice while being diluted, it does not cover uniformly.

**4** With a fine round brush and diluted black finger paint, draw the face, the mane and the rest of the zebra.

**5** Once the colour has dried out, you can cut the paper at the corresponding format and affix it onto the canvas frame by means of the double-sided adhesive tape.
